


# Bain scans of normal / malnourished **1000 Days** Brain scan – two 3 year old children

# No. of malnourished children under 5 years


Number of children under age 5 that are stunted, height for age (millions)





Nurses come back from the orientation to their fields, and educate mothers about the importance of balanced diet with the new education tool.




